It may note that the **price** is not to be quoted either in the Prequalification Bid or Techno - commercial Bid. It shall only be quoted in Price Bid. Non - adherence to this shall make tender liable for rejection. The envelopes containing bids shall be super scribed as 'Pre-Qualification Bid', 'Techno-Commercial Bid' and 'Price Bid' as the case may be for procurement of 400 MPCs (3416 MT) of Rs.20/- Bi-Metallic Coin Blanks.

The sealed envelopes shall again be put in another sealed cover and should be super-scribed as 'Pre-Qualification Bid', 'Techno-Commercial Bid' and 'Price Bid' **due on** Late tender shall not be accepted. Tenderers shall submit their offers only on prescribed form.
